Tropical Water Lilies & Tropical Marginals

Tropical water lilies are difficult to overwinter and are usually treated as annuals; discarded at the end of the season and replaced each year. Tropical marginals, however, can be brought indoors before the frost and treated as house plants.

Floating Plants

Floater are considered a tropical annual and as they start to die off can be removed and discarded to a compost pile.

Regular Hardy Marginals

These types of plants you can just cut back as they die off. Doing this little bit of maintenance now really saves time in the spring!

Fun Frog Fact

We have had so many people tell us about their frogs this year so here is a tip to help these cold-blooded creatures.

To give frogs a place to hibernate right in your very own pond simply place a small container (an old sand pail or plant basket will work) filled about 1/2 way with sand and chopped up leaves. This will give your frogs a place to burrow for the winter.

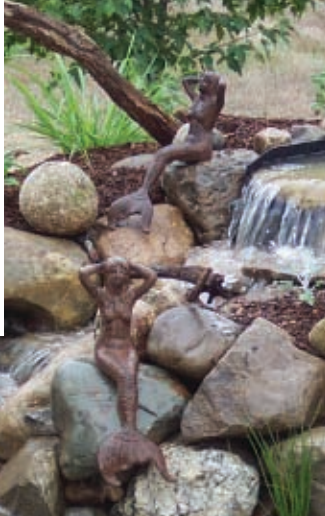

— FALL TIPS —

- 1 Remember water temperature is just as important now as it is in the spring! As long as the water temperature is at least 55° and your fish are active, you can continue to feed them.
 - 2 Fall colors are beautiful, but keep the leaves out of your pond! You can use a net to scoop them out, or even a leaf net if you are surrounded by trees. Also, be sure to check your skimmer on a regular basis as this will ensure proper water circulation.
 - 3 Trimming back any plant debris is also a good idea right now. Doing this now will save time during your spring cleaning.
 - 4 Fall is a wonderful time to plant a wide variety of bulbs around your pond.
 - 5 Last, but not least, continue enjoying your backyard oasis!
